Role Summary

a) The Safeguarding Officer has in overseeing the safety and wellbeing of athletes involved in the Sport of Cheerleading within Scotland. They are responsible to ensure that everyone in the organisation, including members, athletes, coaches, parents, children, staff and volunteers, is aware of the safeguarding policies and also also making sure everyone is aware of what to do if they have a safeguarding concern

Responsibilities

The Safe Guarding Officer will be responsible for:

- Ensuring proper safeguarding policies and procedures are in place.
- Writing and updating policies and procedures
- Coordinate concerns to the relevant agencies
- Respond appropriately to disclosures or concerns which relate to the well-being of an athlete.
- Maintaining accurate, confidential and up-to-date documentation on all cases of safeguarding and child protection and provide reports where required.
- Ensure the national Team have all correct procedures and appropriate volunteers in place.
