### **Role Summary**

The Adaptive Abilities Director of the SportCheer Scotland Board will aim promote and create opportunities for disabled athletes to get involved in Scottish Cheer and Performance Cheer. They will look to develop relationships with clubs, disability organisations and any other relevant partners to support the development of Adaptive Abilities cheerleading in Scotland. Directors will also chair sub committees of the SportCheer Scotland Board to work effectively and collaboratively with stakeholders. All sub committees will be overseen by the SportCheer Scotland's Vice President.

### **Responsibilities**

The Adaptive Abilities Director will be responsible for:

- Representing the interest of SportCheer Scotland athletes with a disability and their clubs at quarterly board meetings and other relevant events where required.
- Developing and maintaining relationships with partners including Cheer and Performance Cheer clubs as well as event producers, Scottish Disability Sport, Special Olympics and any other relevant partners.
- Attending a minimum of three quarterly board meeting per annum and the Annual General Meeting
- Chair Adaptive Abilities Committee and report progress to SportCheer Scotland board
- Aiding the strategic development of cheerleading in Scotland including planning and implementation of initiatives and programmes through action planning
- Assisting in fundraising efforts of SportCheer Scotland
- Promotion of SportCheer Scotland and its membership

And any other responsibilities deemed appropriate by SportCheer Scotland.

### **Eligibility**

- Applicants must be 18 years or above and reside in the region they wish to represent
- Applicant should be a current member of SportCheer Scotland in good standing or willing to join SportCheer Scotland membership scheme.
